NOTICE OF FERC APPROVAL

COMES NOW The Empire District Electric Company (Empire) and states as follows to the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) as Empire's Notice of FERC Approval:

- 1. On December 1, 2008, Empire filed an application with the Commission seeking an order from the Commission addressing the classification of investment in transmission and distribution facilities in light of certain Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) action.
- 2. The Southwest Power Pool (SPP) exercises functional control over all of Empire's transmission assets. Certain SPP tariff changes modified the definition of Transmission Facilities to be used by SPP to provide transmission service under its tariff. (Docket No. ER05-1285-000 (112 FERC P61,355)).
- 3. The SPP tariffs further directed Transmission Owners to file requests based on the new definitions with appropriate regulatory authorities (the state commission) for a determination as to which facilities are Transmission Facilities. Empire's application in this case asked for such a determination.
- 4. On June 13, 2009, the Commission issued its Order Granting Application

 Concerning Reclassification of Certain Transmission and Distribution Facilities, therein

 approving Empire's proposed treatment of its transmission and distribution facilities. Empire

 received similar approval from the other three states in which it operates (Arkansas Docket No.

08-162-U; Kansas – Docket No. 09-EPDE-457-MIS; and, Oklahoma – Cause No. PUD 200800383).

5. After review of the state commission orders, on December 8, 2009, the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) issued its order accepting Empire's proposed transmission/distribution determinations. A copy of that order is attached as **Appendix A** and filed with this Commission for the purpose of completing the Commission's record.

WHEREFORE, Empire respectfully requests the Commission take notice of the attached FERC decision and issue such orders as it shall find to be reasonable and just.
