NOTICE OF COMPLIANCE

COMES NOW The Empire District Electric Company (“Liberty”), and for its Notice of Compliance, respectfully states as follows to the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Commission”):

1. With its Report and Order issued October 21, 2020, effective November 20, 2020, the Commission directed as follows:

Within ten days after the effective date of this Report and Order, Empire shall provide directly to Ms. Feken a copy of such billing records as are necessary to show she remained liable on the guarantee and that the uncollected amount owed by her son was the amount transferred from her son’s account to her account. Empire shall simultaneously file notice of compliance with this order.

2. Pursuant to the Commission’s Report and Order, on November 24, 2020, Liberty, through counsel, sent the attached email communication to Ms. Feken with billing records to demonstrate Ms. Feken remained liable on the guarantee and that the uncollected amount owed by her son was the amount transferred from her son’s account to her account.
