## NOTICE REGARDING MOTION FILED BY MISSOURI STATE DISCOUNT TELEPHONE

On April 27, 2000, the Commission issued an order that dismissed the application for certificate of service authority to provide basic local and interexchange telecommunications service filed by Missouri State Discount Telephone (M-SDT). That dismissal was based on M-SDT's failure to appear for a hearing. The Commission's Order Dismissing Application bore an effective date of May 10, 2000. On May 3, 2000, M-SDT filed a pleading entitled "Motion Requesting Commission Issue New Scheduled Date for Missouri State Discount Telephone to Provide on the Record Presentation." The body of the motion also requests that the Commission not dismiss M-SDT's application.

The Commission will treat this motion as a request for rehearing. Any party wishing to respond to this motion may do so no later than May 15, 2000.
