# STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Missouri Public Service Commission

COMES NOW the Staff ("Staff") of the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") and respectfully states as follows:

- 1. On October 17, 2000, Missouri Gas Energy, a division of Southern Union Company ("MGE"), filed a tariff sheet proposed to become effective on November 1, 2000. On October 27, 2000 MGE filed a substitute tariff sheet. The tariff sheet was filed to reflect a change in MGE's Purchased Gas Adjustment ("PGA") factors, and to reflect changes in the Actual Cost Adjustment ("ACA"), Refund and Transition Cost factors.
- 2. The Staff has reviewed the tariff sheet, and determined that it was calculated in conformance with MGE's PGA Clause. The Staff's memorandum is attached hereto as Attachment A. Staff also is of the opinion that the rates should remain interim, subject to refund, pending final Commission decisions in Case Nos. GR-98-450, GR-98-167, GR-99-304, and this



case. The Staff is of the opinion that good cause has been shown pursuant to §393.140(11), RSMo, to approve this tariff sheet on less than thirty days notice.

WHEREFORE, Staff recommends that the Commission approve the referenced tariff sheet.

On October 17, 2000, Missouri Gas Energy (MGE or Company), a division of Southern Union Company, of Kansas City, Missouri filed a tariff sheet proposed to become effective November 1, 2000. On October 27, 2000, MGE filed a substitute tariff sheet. The tariff sheet was filed to reflect scheduled changes in MGE's Purchased Gas Adjustment (PGA) factors as the result of estimated changes in the cost of gas for the upcoming winter season. Additionally, this tariff filing reflects changes in the Actual Cost Adjustment (ACA), Refund, and Transition Cost (TC) factors.

The net effect of these changes will increase the firm PGA factor for the 2000-2001 winter season to \$0.68056 per Ccf from the current firm PGA factor of \$0.53599 per Ccf.

Case No. GR-2000-425, under which this PGA change was filed, was established to address MGE's PGA factors in its 1999-2000 ACA filings. Case No. GR-99-304 was established to address MGE's PGA factors to be reviewed in its 1998-99 filings. Case No. GR-98-167 was established to address MGE's PGA factors to be reviewed in its 1997-98 filings. Interim subject to refund status should be maintained pending final Commission decisions in Case Nos. GR-96-450, GR-98-167, GR-99-304, and GR-2000-425.

Because of the short time available to review the documentation supporting the ACA factor represented in this filing, the Procurement Analysis Department (PAD) has requested permission to submit its results and recommendation regarding information included in this ACA filing to the Commission on or before December 1, 2001.

The Commission's Gas Department - Tariffs/Rate Design Staff (Staff) has reviewed the filing of October 17, 2000 as substituted On October 27, 2000 and has determined it was calculated in conformance with MGE's Commission approved PGA Clause. Staff is of the opinion that good cause for approval of this tariff sheet on less than thirty (30) days notice is demonstrated by MGE's Commission approved PGA Clause allowing for ten (10) business days notice for PGA change filings. Therefore, Staff recommends that the following tariff sheet filed on October 17, 2000 as substituted On October 27, 2000, be approved, interim subject to refund:
