NOTICE OF CORRECTION

On June 10, 1999, the Commission issued a Report and Order which contained the following sentence in the notice Fidelity Telephone Company (Fidelity) is to send to its customers:

If your current long distance (interLATA) company is not on the attached list and you do not choose another company, after October 20, 1999, you will not be able to make 1+ or 0+ long distance intraLATA calls until you do choose another company.

On June 18, 1999, Fidelity filed a motion for approval to modify its notice by replacing the above sentence with the following sentence:

Should you not choose an intraLATA long distance provider, Fidelity Telephone Company will continue to provide intraLATA long distance service.

Fidelity points out, and the Commission agrees, that the sentence included in the Commission's Report and Order is incorrect. Fidelity's proposed sentence is accurate, and the Commission will correct its June

10, 1999, Report and Order to include it instead of the first sentence cited above.
