WITHDRAWAL OF NOTICE OF CANCELLATION OF INTERCONNECTION AGREEMENT

On April 4, 2000, in case number TD-2000-576, the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) canceled the certificate of service authority for basic local and local exchange access telecommunications services granted to JATO Communications Corp. (JATO) on March 25, 1999, in case number TA-99-148. In this case, the Commission entered a notice on April 4, 2000, wherein it stated that by the action of JATO requesting the cancellation of its certificate, the interconnection agreement between Southwestern Bell Telephone Company (SWBT) and JATO approved by the Commission on August 6, 1999, was thereby canceled.

On April 11, 2000, JATO filed a motion for rehearing or reconsideration, requesting an expedited order immediately reinstating JATO's interconnection agreement with SWBT, since the interconnection agreement was assigned by JATO Communications Corp. to JATO Operating Corp. and is still necessary. However, since the Commission never ordered the interconnection agreement canceled, another order is

unnecessary. A withdrawal of the notice of cancellation will restore the status quo.

The Commission withdraws the April 4, 2000, notice of cancellation of interconnection agreement.
