NOTICE CLOSING CASE

Union Electric Company d/b/a AmerenUE (AmerenUE) filed an Application on November 23, 1998, requesting permission to sell to First Morgan L.L.C. (Morgan) a 2000 kva padmounted, three-phase General Electric transformer.

On May 3, 1999, the Staff of the Commission (Staff) filed its recommendation. Staff stated that the proposed transaction would not be detrimental to the public interest, would not be detrimental to existing AmerenUE customers, and recommended that the Commission approve the sale. Staff also recommended that AmerenUE file a copy of all journal entries made in connection with the sale no later than 90 days after completion of the sale.

On May 10, 1999, the Commission entered its *Order Approving Sale of Assets*, where it ordered, *inter alia*, that Union Electric Company d/b/a AmerenUE file with the Commission a copy of all journal entries made in connection with this sale no later than 90 days after completion of the sale. AmerenUE filed a copy of its journal entries recording the sale

of facilities to Morgan on July 6, 1999, where it showed that the sale was made on May 31, 1999.

Thus, this case may be closed on July 29, 1999.
