NOTICE CLOSING CASE

On April 22, 1998 Capital Utilities, Inc. (CU) submitted a tariff proposing an increase in its Connection Fee from \$300 to \$667.96. The tariff sheet (Second Revised Sheet No. WR 2) was assigned Tariff No. 9800842 and bears an effective date of May 22. On May 11, CU submitted a substitute tariff sheet bearing the same effective date.

Upon a motion of the Office of the Public Counsel, the Commission suspended the tariff until September 19. On September 11, CU filed a letter withdrawing the tariff. 4 CSR 240-116(1) provides that an applicant may voluntarily dismiss an application without an order of the Commission before prepared testimony has been filed or oral evidence has been offered. No prepared testimony has been filed and no oral evidence has been offered, so Capital Utilities, Inc. may voluntarily dismiss its application. This case may now be closed.
