On November 26, 1991, Cuivre River Electric Service Company (CRESCO) filed an application for a waiver of the reporting requirements of 4 CSR 240-20.080. This case has remained open since that time, initially due to ongoing settlement discussions, and then pending resolution of Case No. EM-93-167 which involved, among other issues, rescinding CRESCO's certificate of public convenience and necessity.

Inasmuch as CRESCO no longer exists as an electrical corporation subject to regulation by the Commission, there is no need for a waiver of the reporting requirements of 4 CSR 240-20.080 as requested by CRESCO in this case. Thus, the Commission determines that Staff's motion should be granted, and that CRESCO's application should be dismissed and this docket closed.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the motion filed in this case by the Staff of the Commission on July 2, 1993, is hereby granted.
2. That Cuivre River Electric Service Company's application for a waiver of the reporting requirements of 4 CSR 240-20.080 is hereby dismissed.
3. That Case No. EO-92-115 is hereby closed.
4. That this Order shall become effective on August 3, 1993.
