NOTICE CLOSING CASE

On September 14, 1999, the Commission directed the parties herein to file an Interconnection Agreement, compliant with the terms of the Arbitration Order issued herein by the Commission on August 3, 1999, on or before October 14, 1999. On behalf of the parties, counsel for Southwestern Bell Telephone Company (SWBT) requested an extension of time, which the Commission granted by Order on October 18, 1999. That Order required that the agreement be filed on or before October 28, 1999.

On November 10, 1999, believing that the amendment had never been filed, the Commission issued its Order Directing Filing, requiring the parties to comply with the Order of September 14, 1999, on or before November 22, 1999. On November 22, 1999, the parties filed their joint response, which pointed out that the parties had in fact complied with the Commission's Order and filed the amendment to their

Agreement on October 22, 1999. There being nothing remaining, this case may now be closed.
