**NOTICE ACKNOWLEDGING MODIFICATIONS TO PREFERRED RESOURCE PLAN**

By letter dated January 21, 1999 and filed with the Commission on March 22, Kansas City Power & Light Company (KCPL) notified the Public Service Commission that it has modified its Preferred Resource Plan, which was originally filed in July 1994 in Case No. EO-94-360, and modified by an Agreement approved by the Commission in Case No. EO-97-522. The letter indicates that "due to significant changes in the spot market for electric energy, KCPL concluded that the most economical way to meet its peaking capacity requirement is to purchase two new combustion turbine generators for its Hawthorn Generation Facility, and repower the now idle Hawthorn 4 steam turbine generator." The letter states that the modification does not significantly change the resource plan and that KCPL believes that the filing of a revised implementation plan should not be required. KCPL's letter also indicates that the Staff of the Public Service Commission is aware of this modification and has not objected to it.

Upon the filing of this letter, the Commission determined that proper parties should be given notice and an opportunity to comment regarding this matter. The Commission issued an Order and Notice on

March 29, 1999, which stated that anyone wishing to submit comments regarding KCPL's letter should do so on or before April 28, 1999. No comments have been submitted.

As a result of the lack of comments from interested parties, it appears that there is no need for the Commission to take any action regarding the modification. Therefore, the Commission acknowledges the modification to KCPL's Preferred Resource Plan but will take no other action with regard to the Preferred Resource Plan at this time.
