

NOTICE CANCELING HEARING

On December 18, 1998, a Stipulation and Agreement was filed by George Hoesch/Gascony Water Company (Applicant), the Staff of the Commission, and the Office of the Public Counsel. Because the stipulation resolves all issues among those parties, the evidentiary hearing presently scheduled for December 21 is not necessary. If the Gascony Association retains counsel who enters an appearance on the association's behalf, and if the Association requests a hearing on the stipulation, the Commission will reschedule the evidentiary hearing. The Commission may also, on its own motion, set an on-the-record presentation of the stipulation.
