ORDER SETTING PREHEARING CONFERENCE

The Commission granted United Cities Gas Company's (United Cities) Application for Accounting Authority Order (AAO) on February 25, 1999. The order provided that the AAO would become null and void in the event that United Cities does not file tariff sheets proposing a general increase in rates by March 9, 2001. On February 5, 2001, United Cities filed a motion for modification of the AAO, stating that although it has been actively evaluating the possibility of filing a general rate case in the near future, United Cities does not believe it would be desirable to file a rate case before March 9, 2001. On February 6, 2001, the Office of the Public Counsel (Public Counsel) filed a response opposing United Cities' request. United Cities filed a reply to Public Counsel's response on February 8, 2001.

The Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) filed its suggestions on March 2, 2001, opposing United Cities' request for a one-year extension of the AAO. United Cities filed its reply to Staff's suggestions on March 6, 2001. United Cities filed its Suggestions in Support of Motion for Modification of Accounting Authority Order on March 22, 2001. Staff filed a Motion to Dismiss on March 22, 2001.

A second prehearing conference shall be scheduled to further discuss the jurisdictional issue and, if necessary, to allow the parties to discuss, define, and possibly resolve the issues presented in this case.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That a prehearing conference will be held on July 11, 2001, beginning at 10:30 a.m. The prehearing conference will be held in the Commission's offices in the Governor Office Building, 200 Madison Street, Room 310, Jefferson City, Missouri. The Governor Office Building meets accessibility standards required by the Americans With Disabilities Act.
