

NOTICE CLOSING CASE

On December 30, 1998, Sprint Missouri, Inc. d/b/a Sprint (Sprint) filed a proposed tariff with the Commission for permission to introduce "Sprint Solutions," a new residence service enrollment plan. On January 7, 1999, the Mid-Missouri Group filed an application to intervene and a motion to suspend Sprint's tariff. The Small Telephone Company Group filed a similar application to intervene and a motion to suspend on January 15.

On January 19, counsel for Sprint filed a letter with the Commission by which Sprint notified the Commission of its intent to withdraw its tariff, Tariff No. 9900496. The withdrawal of Sprint's tariff renders moot the applications and motions of The Small Telephone Company Group and the Mid-Missouri Group. Tariff No. 9900496 having been withdrawn, no further action is required. Therefore, this case may be closed.
