**Subject:** Notes and Request for Additional Input for the ARC/ISO/RTO Demand Response Aggregation Draft Rule Workshop held on Monday, April 11, 2011

Attached please find notes from our April 11 ARC DR Workshop. Please review these notes and provide a markup of the attached file for any changes by April 29. In addition, staff is requesting additional stakeholder input by April 29 as follows.

### The staff is requesting comments and input for items 7 and 8 of the draft rule since these items were not addressed during the workshop due to time constraints.

"(7) The Commission reserves the right to set the MFRR, or any successor or equivalent to the MFRR. The Commission initially proposes to set the MFFR for Demand Response at the current effective retail rate of the End Use Customer.

(8) The Commission Staff shall, no later than three (3) years after (a) the effective date of this rule or (b) the most recent submission of a report under this section of the rule, produce a report regarding the status of ARCs in areas where the Commission is the RERRA. This report shall include any recommendations for changes to this rule. The report shall include a review of any ISO / RTO market monitor reports regarding ARCs."

# The staff is also requesting any additional input concerning the proposed 100 MW DR cap included in item 2 (b) as follows.

"(2) An ARC shall not directly aggregate the Demand Response of an End Use Customer of an Electric Utility where the Commission is the RERRA unless:

a. The ARC is properly registered as a market participant with the ISO / RTO that the Electric Utility is a member of, as defined in the relevant ISO / RTO Governing Market Rules Documents.;

b. The Demand Response of the End Use Customers(s), added to the existing Demand Response already aggregated by ARCs in the Electric Utility's Balancing Authority Area, is less than 100 megawatts (MW); and

c. The ARC has followed the proper ISO / RTO procedure, as described in the relevant ISO / RTO's Governing Market Rules Documents, regarding registering the End Use Customer's Demand Response."

Suggestions to date include.

- 1. No Cap
- 2. 10 MW for KCPL
- 3. 5 MW for GMO
- 4. 100 MW is ok

5. Represent Cap as a trigger point, i.e. % of load or available generation, or allowing ARCs to operate based on the current demand response program size of the electrical utility.
