 The MOPSC staff posted the notes from ARC workshop in docket EW-2010-0187. I am not much of a stickler for this sort of thing generally, but I worry that my characterization of the EnergyConnect Order is not accurate in the notes. I could have said it wrong or it may be wrong in the notes, but below and attached is red-line language that would fix my concern.

Question 1

C. Ken Schisler – Agrees, FERC has said that DR provider is not a public utility; ~~the A~~ customer who injects energy back to the grid may be a public utility under federal law. Most states don't regulate DR providers as public utilities either. Energy Connect Order – neither customer nor ARC is a public customer unless the customer injects energy; If the customer injects energy, then under FERC guidelines they may consider ~~you~~ the customer and not the DR provider to be a utility, but not per state requirements.
