#### NOTICE DIRECTING RESPONSE TO MEDIATION REQUEST

On August 30, 1999, John McCullough filed a complaint with the Missouri Public Service Commission against Associated Natural Gas Company, a division of Arkansas Western Gas Company (ANG), regarding a billing disagreement. The Commission issued a Notice of Complaint on September 1, providing 30 days for ANG to file an answer, or, in the alternative, to file a request for mediation. ANG did not file an answer within 30 days and on October 12, the Commission issued an Order of Default. On October 14, ANG filed an Application for Rehearing and Motion to Set Aside Default Order. The Commission has not yet ruled on that Application and Motion.

On October 25, a letter from Mr. McCullough was filed. A copy of that letter is attached to this notice. In his letter, Mr. McCullough indicates that he is willing to meet with a third party to discuss this matter. The Commission will treat Mr. McCullough's

letter as a request for mediation. If ANG agrees to mediation of this dispute, then this proceeding will be stayed pending the mediation process. The Commission will also defer its ruling on ANG's Application for Rehearing and Motion to Set Aside Default Order until after it is determined whether or not this matter will proceed through mediation.

If ANG declines the mediation request or does not respond within 15 days of the date of this Order, the Commission will proceed with this case by ruling on ANG's Application for Rehearing and Motion to Set Aside Default Order.
