### NOTICE DISMISSING CASE


On October 6, 1999, Trigen-Kansas City Energy Corporation (Trigen) filed a notice of dismissal of its application pursuant to Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) Rule 4 CSR 240-2.116(1), which states, in part, that

...[a]n applicant...may voluntarily dismiss an application... without an order of the commission at any time before prepared testimony has been filed or oral evidence has been offered by filing a notice of dismissal with the commission and serving a copy on all parties....

There has been no prepared testimony filed nor has there been any oral evidence offered; thus the notice complies with this rule.

Because Trigen has dismissed its application, this case may now be closed.
