RULES, REGULATIONS, AND CONDITIONS OF SERVICE

11. INSTALLATION OF SERVICE LINES - Continued

(M) For service at a new location, applicant shall pay, in advance, a service connection charge as follows:

3/4" Single Meter Service Connection	\$552	+
3/4" Dual Meter Service Connection (with 1" service line)	\$778	+

If one side of a dual connection is used, customer shall pay only one-half of the \$778 charge, or \$389. For a service larger than 3/4", the service connection shall be equal to the cost of installing a meter and service connection. Any income tax liability will be added to the service connection fee. +

(N) Customers' water services will not be extended along public streets or roadways or through property of others in connecting with water mains. If a service connection is requested at a point not already served by a main of adequate capacity, the Company shall extend its mains as provided in Rule 22.

(O) Any change in the location and/or size of an existing service connection requested by the Customer shall be made at his expense.

(P) New service connections for yearly services shall be furnished and installed by the Company for the charges as set forth in Rule 11 (m). All additional installation and maintenance costs shall be at the expense of the Company.

**INTERRUPTIBLE RATE WATER SERVICE\***

**APPLICABILITY:** Throughout the territory served under this Rider.

**AVAILABILITY:** This Rider is available to any current metered customer that:

1. Agrees to contract for service for a minimum of fifteen (15) years.
2. Agrees to a minimum take or pay annual revenue level of no less than \$500,000.
3. The Customer must provide proof that it has a viable alternative supply or a combination of supply and storage sufficient to cover an interruption of service.
4. The Customer and the Company must agree on service provisioning issues such as point of delivery, pressure, metering, interruption, etc.
5. The Customer must agree to pay for any additional equipment or facilities which may be required to provide service.
6. If an existing Customer chooses to convert its service to an interruptible service, such conversion will take place only upon the effective date of the Company's next general rate proceeding where the revenue impact associated with such conversion can be taken into consideration, with all other relevant factors, in determining the Company's cost of service in that district.

**RATE:**

Monthly Minimum Meter Charges

The Monthly Minimum Meter Charges under this rate schedule will be the same as those set forth on the Schedule of Rates Applicable to the District for the Rate Class.

Consumption Charges

The consumption charge shall not exceed the maximum rate nor be less than the minimum rate. The maximum rate for water shall be the charges specified in the Company's rate schedule for the last (i.e., "tail") block rate for the rate class of service and shall be charged for all amounts of water taken up to the minimum take or pay annual revenue level. The minimum rate shall be the fully loaded production cost of water under average load conditions and shall be charged for all amounts of water taken above the minimum take or pay annual revenue level. For purposes of this tariff, the term "fully loaded production cost" shall include all operating expenses, taxes, and capital costs (i.e. return and depreciation) related to the production of water.

Filing with the Missouri Public Service Commission/Confidentiality: Contract agreements entered into between the Company and qualifying customers under this rider shall be filed with the Commission on a confidential basis within ten (10) days of their execution and shall not be subject to disclosure except by Petition made to and granted by the Commission.

**BILLING:**

Billing for water service under this tariff will be governed by the same billing conditions set forth under the Company's existing General Water Service Classification.
