NOTICE REGARDING COMPLIANCE WITH REPORT AND ORDER

On June 4, 1997, the Commission issued an order which both directed the Staff to comply with the prior Report and Order and also approve the permissive and mandatory dialing implementation. That order identified 12 numbered items for which the Commission anticipated receiving a response from the committee established to this case. That order further noted that only item number 12 had been completely fulfilled. The committee to this case subsequently requested clarification as to the items which might require some response and also as to whether that information should address the 816/660 NPA or the 314 NPA.

For the sake of clarification, the Commission would note that the implementation of the 816/660 split appears to be proceeding on course and no further reports are necessary for that NPA. The Commission will issue an order regarding the 816/660 split in the near future to address any pending motions. The Commission will not anticipate hearing from the committee on the 816/660 NPA until it is time for the Commission to review the proposals for jointly sponsored public service announcements.

The Commission does anticipate hearing from the committee regarding the 314 NPA which was to be filed on June 20, 1997. However, in order to allow the committee sufficient time to respond to this notice the Commission will extend that due date to June 24, 1997.

As indicated in the previous order, that report should contain information such as a draft of the letter which the committee proposes to distribute and the recipients to whom that letter will be addressed. The Commission would expect that along with that letter the committee will propose dates, times and locations for any press conferences or other such public meetings as well as the personnel from the committee, or outside the committee, to be involved in those meetings. The Commission would also anticipate the committee bringing forward any proposed materials, public notices or public service announcements which the committee proposes to disseminate with regard to the 314 NPA exhaust. The Commission recognizes that the committee would not be in a position at this time to set out a proposal for the technical transition until the solution has been identified for the 314 NPA. However, the Commission would expect the parties to propose a time line which sets up a procedural schedule for activities to take place regarding the 314 NPA up to and including the date upon which the Commission might reasonably expect to issue a decision regarding a solution to the 314 exhaust.
