## **ORDER**

The Commission approved an agreement between the Staff of the Commission (Staff) and Kansas City Power & Light Company (KCPL) on February 23, 1996. The agreement and Commission order reflect that KCPL accepted all Staff recommendations and this case was left open for periodic compliance reports.

On July 11, 1997, the Staff filed a request to close this case but the Commission demurred stating, "This docket shall remain open until KCPL complies with the original Commission order and all parties agree that full compliance has been made."

In regard to the KCPL filing of December 31, 1997, the Commission shall direct the Staff to advise the Commission as to KCPL's current progress and compliance efforts to date no later than 30 days from the effective date of this order.

1. That the Staff shall file a pleading regarding the compliance efforts of Kansas City Power & Light Company no later than February 11, 1998.

2. That this order shall become effective on January 12,

1998.
