ORDER

On February 22, 1987, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) filed its Motion for Further Extension of Time for Submission of Revised Jurisdictional Reporting Requirements. Therein, the Staff on its own behalf and for all participating parties requested an extension of approximately sixty (60) days until May 1, 1987, to file revised jurisdictional reporting requirements. Staff and the participating parties state that due to the time and resources they expended in the transition from intrastate interLATA pooling to individual local exchange carrier access tariffs and in the negotiations and analysis related to formulation of a proposed replacement mechanism for intrastate intraLATA pooling, an extension of time is needed. Staff stated that this extension of time is either supported by or not

opposed by the parties which participated at the February 23, 1987 meeting on jurisdictional reporting requirements.


Having considered the motion, the Commission finds that it is reasonable and should be granted.
