NOTICE OF DEFICIENCY IN APPLICATION

Missouri State Discount Telephone filed an Application for Certificate of Service Authority and for Competitive Classification with the Commission on September 1, 1999. The Application is not subscribed and verified by affidavit under oath as required by 4 CSR 240-2.060(1)(F). Until this deficiency is corrected, the Commission will be unable to take any further action on the Application.

The Commission also notes that although the Applicant requests authority to provide interexchange, long-distance service as well as basic local service, it requests only the waiver of statutes and regulations standard for competitive basic local service. Applicant does not request the standard waivers for competitive long-distance service. If the Applicant does wish to obtain the additional waivers for competitive long-distance service, it will need to amend its application to request the appropriate waivers.

When a verified, amended application is filed, it shall indicate that it is filed in Case No. TA-2000-204.
