**NOTICE CLOSING CASE**

On May 13, 1999, the Commission issued an order granting Central Rivers Wastewater Utility, Inc. a certificate of convenience and necessity. In that order, the Commission established a 24-month period for review of the appropriateness of the sewer rates, and ordered Staff to file its recommendation regarding the appropriateness of the sewer rates at the conclusion of the 24-month period. For the purposes of administrative efficiency, the Commission will close this case. However, Staff may still file the results of its rate review in this case even

though it is closed. Other than Staff's rate review filing, no further activity will take place in this case, and it may now be closed.
