NOTICE SETTING TIME FOR RESPONSE

On September 4, 1998, George Hoesch (Applicant) filed a Motion to Extend Procedural Schedule in Case No. WA-97-510, another case involving Applicant. In that motion, Applicant requests that the Commission amend the procedural schedule in Case No. WA-97-510 so that it runs concurrently with the schedule in this case. Applicant states that neither the Staff of the Commission nor the Office of the Public Counsel object to this request. No mention is made of the position of Gascony Association, Inc., an intervenor in Case No. WA-97-510 as well as in this case, with respect to the extension.
