**APPLICATION FOR INTERVENTION OF
MIDWEST ENERGY CONSUMER'S GROUP**

COMES NOW the Midwest Energy Consumer's Group, pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.075 and the Commission's February 28, 2012 *Order Suspending Tariff, Setting Prehearing Conference, and Directing Filings; and Notice of Contested Case and Hearings*, and for its Application for Intervention in this case, states as follows:

1. Midwest Energy Consumer's Group ("MECG") is an unincorporated association consisting of large commercial and industrial users of electricity. For purposes of this case, MECG consists of Wal-Mart Stores, Inc. It is possible that other large commercial and industrial users may join MECG in the near future. MECG will notify the Commission as additional members join.

2. On February 27, 2012, KCPL – Greater Missouri Operations ("GMO") filed proposed tariffs with the Commission intending to increase its rates for electric service by \$58.3 million (10.9%) for its MPS operations and \$25.2 million (14.6%) for its L&P operations. As a group of large commercial and industrial customers of GMO, MECG's interest in this case is different than that of the general public.

4. For purposes of 4 CSR 240-2.075(2), MECG states that it is opposed to discriminatory pricing of electricity and related utility services, is opposed to increases that are not reasonable and are not related to prudent costs that are incurred by the utility

in providing utility service, and is opposed to a utility being permitted to earn what may be an unreasonably high rate of return. MECG is unable to state its position relating to the relief sought by GMO. MECG is continuing to review GMO's filing and reserves the right to take positions on specific issues as this case proceeds.

5. MECG's intervention will serve the public interest by assisting the record for the Commission's decision in this case.
