<u>APPLICATION TO INTERVENE</u>

Come now the Small Telephone Company Group, which companies are set out in Attachment A, (hereinafter referred to as "Applicants") and in support of their Application to Intervene in the above-captioned matter state that:

- 1. Applicants currently provide telecommunications services to members of the public located in those areas certificated to them by the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission"). As is relevant to this case, Applicants provide "basic local telecommunications services" within the exchanges as defined by their respective tariffs which are on file with and approved by the Commission. Applicants are "telecommunications companies" and "public utilities" as those terms are defined by § 386.020, RSMo Supp. 1998, and are, therefore, subject to the jurisdiction, regulation and control of the Commission as provided by law. Applicants also are rural telephone companies and incumbent local exchange carriers as defined by the Federal Telecommunications Act of 1996 (the "Act").

- 3. On November 29, 1999, CAT COMMUNICATIONS INTERNATIONAL, INC. ("CCII") filed an Application requesting a certificate of service authority to provide basic local exchange telecommunications service and interexchange service in the State of Missouri. Specifically, CCII wishes to provide interexchange and basic local exchange telecommunications service on a non-facilities, resold basis throughout all exchanges currently served by all incumbent local exchange telecommunication companies in the State of Missouri.
- 4. The Commission issued its Order and Notice setting an intervention deadline of January 13, 1999.
- 5. The Small Telephone Company Group files this Application to Intervene in the instant proceeding on the grounds that the granting or denying of a certificate of service authority to provide basic local telecommunications services throughout all exchanges currently served by all incumbent local exchange telecommunication companies in the State of Missouri will directly affect Applicants' interests as providers of telecommunication services in Missouri. Applicants thus have an interest in this proceeding that is different from that of the general public.
