ORDER DIRECTING CASE STATUS REPORT

On February 23, 1996, the Commission issued its Order Regarding an Incident of July 1, 1995. As a part of that order, the Commission adopted the recommendations of the Staff of the Commission (Staff) and ordered Kansas City Power & Light Company (KCPL) to comply with those recommendations as soon as practical.

On December 31, 1997, KCPL filed a progress report updating the Commission on the current status of compliance. On January 23, 1998, Staff visited the La Cygne Station to discuss and observe KCPL's progress. On February 10 Staff filed its memorandum concluding that KCPL is in compliance with the Commission's original order except for the installation of the Iatan simulator, and subsequent operator training. Staff recommends the Commission issue an order directing KCPL to report by December 31 on the status of progress being made on the Iatan simulator and Iatan operator training program.

The Commission has reviewed KCPL's compliance report, the Staff recommendation and the original Commission order issued February 23, 1996, and finds that this case should remain open until KCPL fully

complies with the original Commission order. The Commission will direct KCPL to file a compliance status report by December 31, 1998.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That Kansas City Power & Light Company shall file a status report with the Commission by December 31, 1998 regarding Kansas City Power & Light Company's progress towards full compliance with the Commission's order of February 23, 1996.
- 2. That this case will remain open until compliance in full with the Commission's order of February 23, 1996 is achieved.
 - 3. That this order shall become effective on July 7, 1998.
