#### STAFF RECOMMENDATION

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) and for its recommendation states:

- 1. In the attached Memorandum, which is labeled Appendix A, the Staff recommends that the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) grant Pathnet, Inc. (Applicant) a certificate of authority to provide interexchange telecommunications services, and a certificate of authority to provide local exchange telecommunications services restricted to dedicated private line services. The Commission shall grant an application for a certificate of telecommunications service authority upon a finding that the grant of authority is in the public interest. (See §§ 392.430 and 392.440 RSMo 1994.)
- 2. Staff also recommends that the Commission classify the Applicant and its services as competitive. The Commission may classify a telecommunications provider or its services as competitive if the Commission determines it is subject to sufficient competition to justify a lesser degree of regulation. (See §392.361.2 RSMo 1994.) All the services a competitive company provides must be classified as competitive. (See §392.361.3 RSMo 1994.)
- 3. Staff further recommends that the Commission approve the waivers listed in the Notice of Application with the exception of 4 CSR 24-35 as the Applicant requested. The Commission may waive the application of its rules and certain statutes if the Commission

determines that waiver is consistent with the purposes of Chapter 392 RSMo. (See §§ 392.361.3 and 392.420 RSMo 1994, and § 392.185 RSMo Supp. 1999.)

4. Finally, Staff recommends that the Commission waive, at this time, the requirement that the tariff be filed with the application for certification. The Staff recommends that the certificates become effective on the effective date of the tariff.

WHEREFORE, Staff recommends that the Commission grant Pathnet, Inc. certificates to provide interexchange telecommunications services, and local exchange telecommunications services restricted to dedicated private line services, grant Applicant competitive classification, approve the waivers listed in the Notice of Applications with the exception of 4 CSR 24-35, and waive the requirement that the tariff be filed with the application for certification.

Pathnet, Inc. (Pathnet) has requested that the requirement that the tariff be filed with the application for certification be waived at this time. Also, Pathnet is not asking that all of the standard waivers mentioned in the Notice be waived. Specifically, Pathnet is not asking that 4 CSR 24-35 be waived.

Staff recommends that the Commission grant approval of the requested certificate for interexchange and nonswitched local exchange authority upon approval of the interexchange tariff. Staff also recommends that the Commission direct Pathnet to file its tariff within 45 days.
