STAFF RECOMMENDATION

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) and for its recommendation states:

1. OnSite Access Local LLC, a New York limited liability company authorized to do business in the State of Missouri, on April 27, 2000 filed with this Commission an application, which was amended on June 20, 2000, seeking (1) authority to provide resold and facilities-based interexchange and non-switched local exchange telecommunications services in the State of Missouri, (2) competitive status for both the company and its services and (3) waiver of the requirements of the following statutes and rules:

These are the same statutes and rules that the Commission listed in the Notice of Applications it issued on May 2, 2000 wherein it fixed an intervention date of June 1, 2000 for this case. No parties have intervened. As part of its application, OnSite Access Local LLC submitted its proposed tariff. Contemporaneously with the filing of its application, the Company filed a motion for a protective order. The Commission granted that motion. Originally the proposed effective date of the proposed tariff filed by OnSite Access Local LLC in this case was June 11, 2000. The Company extended the effective date and submitted substitute tariff sheets on several dates. By letter filed February 27, 2001 the Company last extended the tariff effective date to May 16, 2001. The Company filed substitute tariff sheets on June 8, 2000; November 6, 2000; November 7, 2000; November 27, 2000; and April 25, 2001.

- 2. In the attached Memorandum, which is labeled Appendix A, the Staff recommends that the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") grant to OnSite Access Local LLC a certificate to provide interexchange and dedicated, private line local exchange telecommunications services. The Commission shall grant an application for a certificate of telecommunications service authority upon a finding that the grant of authority is in the public interest. (See §§ 392.430 and 392.440, RSMo 2000).
- 4. Staff also recommends that the Commission classify the company OnSite Access Local LLC and its services as competitive. The Commission may classify a telecommunications provider or its services as competitive if the Commission determines it is subject to sufficient competition to justify a lesser degree of regulation. (See §392.361.2 RSMo 2000). All the services a competitive company provides must be classified as competitive. (See §392.361.3 RSMo 2000).

- 5. The Staff recommends that the Commission approve for OnSite Access Local LLC the waivers listed in the Notice of Applications the Commission issued on May 2, 2000. The Commission may waive the application of its rules and certain statutes if the Commission determines that waiver is consistent with the purposes of Chapter 392 RSMo (See §§ 392.361.3, 392.420 and § 392.185 RSMo 2000).
- 6. The Staff recommends approval of the tariff filed by OnSite Access Local LLC, as substituted. The Commission is to review a tariff to assure the provisions thereof are both lawful and just and reasonable. See §§ 392.190 to 392.530, RSMo, generally and 392.200, RSMo 2000, in particular.

WHEREFORE, the Staff recommends that the Commission grant OnSite Access Local LLC a certificate to provide interexchange and dedicated, private line local exchange telecommunications services, grant Applicant competitive classification, approve Applicant's proposed tariff, PSC MO No. 1 with a proposed effective date of May 16, 2001, and approve the waivers listed in the Notice of Applications.
