**ORDER GRANTING LEAVE TO AMEND APPLICATION**  
**AND EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE STIPULATION**  
**AND AGREEMENT**

On April 28, 2000, OnFiber Carrier Services, Inc. (OnFiber), filed an application for authority to provide and/or resell basic local, local exchange and interexchange telecommunications services. The Public Service Commission (Commission) granted OnFiber's Motion to Adopt Protective Order on May 23, 2000. On June 8, 2000, the Commission entered a Notice of Deficiency and Order Directing Filing, ordering OnFiber to file a pleading setting forth a specific reference to the statutory authority under which OnFiber requested relief, pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.080(3), by June 19, 2000,

Pursuant to the Commission's Order, OnFiber submitted a Motion to Amend by Interlineation the First Page of the Application so that the first paragraph of the first page of its application should read:

OnFiber Carrier Services, Inc. ("OnFiber" or "Applicant") hereby requests authority, pursuant to §§392.410, 392.430, and 392.450 RSMo, to operate as a local exchange, basic local exchange and interexchange provider of telecommunications services on a facilities and resale basis to customers throughout Missouri as hereinafter more specifically described.

Furthermore, OnFiber filed a Motion for Extension of Time to File Stipulation and Agreement on July 10, 2000. In its Motion, OnFiber asserts that the Stipulation and Agreement was due on June 10, 2000, and, although nearly completed, OnFiber requires additional time. OnFiber requests the Commission allow it until August 10, 2000, to file the Stipulation and Agreement.

Pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.080(21), "[a]ny pleading may be amended within ten (10) days of filing, unless a responsive pleading has already been filed, or at any time by leave of the commission." OnFiber's request to amend its application was filed more than ten days after its application. However, the Commission will grant OnFiber leave to amend its application as requested.

Furthermore, the Commission has reviewed the July 10, 2000, motion for an extension until August 10, 2000, to file the Stipulation and Agreement and finds that it is reasonable under the circumstances, and should be granted.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

1. That the Motion to Amend by Interlineation the First Page of the Application filed by OnFiber Carrier Services, Inc., is granted.
2. That the Motion for Extension of Time to File Stipulation and Agreement is granted and that OnFiber Carrier Services, Inc., shall have until August 10, 2000, to file the Stipulation and Agreement.

3. That this order shall become effective on August 8, 2000.
