ORDER GRANTING REQUEST TO WITHDRAW INTERVENTION

On April 28, 2000, OnFiber Carrier Services, Inc. (OnFiber), filed an application for authority to provide and/or resell basic local, local exchange and interexchange telecommunications services in the state of Missouri under 4 CSR 240-2.060. The Commission granted OnFiber's Motion to Amend by Interlineation the First Page of the Application on July 28, 2000. On October 27, 2000, OnFiber filed a second motion to amend the application, asking that the Commission delete its request for authority to provide basic local exchange service. The Commission granted the request on November 17, 2000.

On November 22, 2000, Southwestern Bell Telephone Company (SWBT) filed a Notice of Dismissal. SWBT states that since the services that OnFiber seeks to offer will no longer be offered in direct competition with SWBT, SWBT has no direct interest in the Commission's decision on OnFiber's application. Therefore, SWBT requests that the Commission dismiss it from this case.

The Commission has reviewed SWBT's request for dismissal from the case and concludes that the request should be granted.


