

REPORT ON STATUS OF CASE

Come now First Fiber Corporation d/b/a Iamo Long Distance ("First Fiber") and Fiber Four Corporation d/b/a Iamo Long Distance ("Fiber Four") and for their Report on Status of Case state to the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") as follows:

1. On May 17, 2000, First Fiber and Fiber Four filed a Joint Application with the Commission requesting a certificate of service authority for First Fiber to provide interexchange telecommunications service and authority to transfer certain assets necessary to the provision of that service from Fiber Four to First Fiber.

2. On June 29, the Commission issued an order approving the transactions set out in the application. Ordered paragraph 6 of the order directed First Fiber to report to the Commission within ten (10) days of the completion of the approved transfer that it had been accomplished.


3. On September 7, 2000, the Commission issued its Order Directing Filing directing First Fiber to file with the Commission a report on the status of the case no later than September 22, 2000.

4. On July 31, 2000, counsel for First Fiber filed a letter with the Secretary of the Commission in which it stated that the transfer of the assets from Fiber Four Corporation to First Fiber was completed and effective as of July 23, 2000. A copy of that letter is marked Appendix A and attached to this pleading.

Wherefore, First Fiber respectfully requests that the Commission accept this Report on Status of Case and consider the information contained therein as full compliance with the directive of the Commission.


