NOTICE CLOSING CASE

In the order approving interexchange and non-switched local exchange certificates of service authority, order approving tariff, and order approving transfer of assets and cancellation of certificate issued by the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) on June 29, 2000, it was ordered, *inter alia*, that First Fiber Corporation d/b/a IAMO Long Distance (First Fiber) and Fiber Four Corporation d/b/a IAMO Long Distance (Fiber Four)(collectively, parties) should report to the Commission within ten business days of the completion of the approved transfer that such had been accomplished.

Since nothing had been filed since the date the Commission entered the order above, on September 7, 2000, the Commission ordered that the parties should, no later than September 22, 2000, file with the Commission a report on the status of this case.

On September 8, 2000, the parties filed their report on the status of the case. The parties stated, *inter alia*, that on July 31, 2000, the parties filed a letter with the Commission which stated that the transfer of the assets from Fiber Four to First Fiber was completed and effective as of July 23, 2000. The parties stated that a copy of that letter was marked Appendix A and attached to its report on the status of the case.

Appendix A did not show that the letter to the Commission had been file-stamped when it was purportedly filed on July 31, 2000. Further, an examination of the official case file did not reveal the letter from the parties ever having been filed.

Nonetheless, the filing by the parties on September 8, 2000, fully complies with both the Commission's order of June 29, 2000, and also the order of September 7, 2000.

Thus, this case may be closed.
