**KLM LONG DISTANCE COMPANY'S
RESPONSE TO STAFF RECOMMENDATION**


Comes now KLM Long Distance Company ("KLM") and for its Response to Staff Recommendation states to the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") as follows:

1. On May 26, 2000, KLM and Fiber Four Corporation ("Fiber Four") filed a Joint Application with the Commission requesting a certificate of service authority to provide interexchange telecommunications services for KLM and requesting authority to transfer certain assets of Fiber Four now used in the provision of long distance service for Fiber Four d/b/a KLM Long Distance.

2. On June 26, 2000, Staff filed its Recommendation in which it recommended that the Commission grant the relief requested by Joint Applicants. In referring to KLM Long Distance Company, however, the Staff stated that KLM sought a certificate of service authority to provide interexchange services under the alias of "KLM Long Distance." KLM does not seek a certificate using a fictitious name, but rather seeks a certificate in its corporate and legal name - KLM Long Distance Company.

Wherefore, KLM Long Distance Company respectfully requests that the Staff correct its Recommendation to clarify that the authority is sought for KLM Long Distance Company and not KLM Long Distance Company d/b/a KLM Long Distance.


