Comes now Spectra Communications Group, LLC ("Spectra" or "Applicant") and for its Amendment to Application states to the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") as follows:


1. On June 14, 2000, Spectra filed an application with the Commission requesting that it be designated as an eligible carrier to receive Universal Service Fund support pursuant to Section 254 of the Telecommunications Act of 1996.
2. On June 19, 2000, the Commission issued its Order Directing Filing directing Spectra to file an amended pleading or exhibit in order to comply with Commission rules 4 CSR 240-2.060(1)(K) and (L).
3. Since Spectra is a newly certificated company which has not yet begun to provide service to customers, Spectra does not have any pending action or final unsatisfied judgments or decisions against it from any state or federal agency or court which involve customer service or rates, which action, judgment or decision has occurred within three (3) years of the date of the application.

4. Since Spectra is a newly certificated company which has not yet begun to provide service to customers, no annual report or assessment fees are overdue.

Wherefore, Spectra respectfully requests that the Commission accept its Amendment to Application and consider the information found therein along with its prior Application and for any other relief appropriate in the circumstances.


