
3. Surrender of the certificate is not detrimental to the public interest.

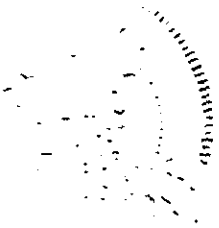
