STAFF RECOMMENDATION

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) and for its recommendation states:

- 1. In the attached Memorandum, which is labeled Appendix A, the Staff recommends that the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) cancel the certificate of service authority to provide interexchange telecommunications service and the accompanying tariff of Calls For Less, Inc.
- 2. The Commission's authority to cancel this certificate is pursuant to section 392.410.5 RSMo Supp. 1999.
- 3. The Staff concludes that surrender of the certificate is not detrimental to public interest because Calls For Less, Inc. states that it has no customers in Missouri.

WHEREFORE, the Staff recommends that the Commission cancel the certificate of service authority to provide interexchange telecommunications service and the accompanying tariff of Calls For Less, Inc.

On February 14, 2000, Calls For Less, Inc. (CFL), a competitive telecommunications company, filed its Surrender of Certificate of Service Authority. CFL was certificated to provide interexchange telecommunications services on May 19, 1995 in Case No. TA-95-256. According to CFL's Chief Financial Officer, CFL has no customers in Missouri, so surrender of the certificate is not detrimental to the public interest.

The Telecommunications Department Staff (Staff) has no objections to CFL's request and recommends that the Commission issue an order to cancel the certificate of service authority to provide interexchange telecommunications service and the accompanying tariff at its earliest convenience. The Staff is unaware of any other filing which affects or which would be affected by this proposal.
