SUPPLEMENT TO APPLICATION

Pathnet, Inc. (Applicant or Pathnet), a Delaware corporation, files this supplement to its above entitled application in order to conform the application to the Commission's revision of its rules at 4 CSR 240.

Pathnet's original application, filed on April 19, 2000, contained among other things a request that its services be categorized as competitive and a request for waiver of several of the Commission's rules that have previously been waived for carriers offering only competitive services. We were subsequently informed by PSC staff member Walter Cecil that Pathnet's application would be evaluated pursuant to the Commission's new rules, and as a result, some changes needed to be made in our requests for waivers. After reviewing the new provisions with Mr. Cecil, Pathnet offers the following as a replacement for section 9 of its original application:

9. Pathnet is willing to comply with all applicable Commission rules and is willing to meet all relevant service standards, including, but not limited to, billing, quality of service, and tariff filing and maintenance.

Consistent with the Commission's treatment of other certificated competitive local exchange telecommunications companies, Pathnet requests, pursuant to Section 392.420, RSMo (Cumm. Supp. 1994), that the following statutes and regulations be waived for Pathnet and its basic local exchange service offerings:

The above-referenced statutes and commission rules have been waived with respect to other local exchange carriers in prior cases, and they remain waivable for competitive carriers even after the recent revisions to the Commission's rules.
