APPLICATION FOR CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE AUTHORITY AND FOR COMPETITIVE CLASSIFICATION

OnSite Access Local, LLC ("OnSite" or "Applicant"), by its undersigned counsel, hereby applies, pursuant to §§ 392.410, 392.430, 392.440, 392.450, and 392.455, RSMo. 1994; 4 CSR 240-2060(4), and the Federal Telecommunications Act of 1996 Pub. L. No. 104-104, 100 Stat. 56, approved February 8, 1996, for a Certificate of Service Authority to provide resold and facilities-based intrastate basic local telecommunications services in the State of Missouri. Additionally, pursuant to §§ 392.420 and 392.361, RSMo. 1994 OnSite requests that said services be classified as competitive and to waive certain statutes and regulations. In support of its application, OnSite provides the following information.

I. INTRODUCTION

II. QUALIFICATIONS

- 6. OnSite, a limited liability company organized under the laws of New York on February 7, 1997, is a wholly-owned subsidiary of OnSite Access, Inc., a Delaware holding company. As of January 3, 2000, OnSite is authorized to transact business in the State of Missouri. OnSite's Articles of Organization and a copy of its Certificate of Authority to Transact Business in Missouri are attached hereto as Exhibit 1 and Exhibit 2, respectively.
- 7. OnSite is financially qualified to provide resold and facilities-based intrastate basic local telecommunications services in the State of Missouri. Through its parent company, OnSite has access to the financing and capital necessary to conduct the telecommunications services as specified in this application. OnSite will rely upon its existing personnel and resources, both technological and financial, to provide intrastate telecommunications services. In support of OnSite's application, attached hereto as Exhibit 3, under seal and subject to a request for confidential treatment, is a copy of the most recent financial statement for OnSite's parent company, OnSite Access, Inc.¹
- 8. OnSite has the managerial and technical qualifications to provide intrastate telecommunications services in Missouri. OnSite's management team has considerable experience in network operations, financial analysis/accounting, marketing, sales, customer service, training,

The submitted financial documents include the predecessor entities of OnSite Access, Inc., as follows: the parent company was originally formed on July 5, 1996, under the name Veritech Ventures LLC. Effective May 18, 1998, the parent company was reorganized under the name OnSite Ventures LLC (see 1998 financial statements, note 1). On June 30, 1999, OnSite Ventures LLC was merged into a newly formed corporation under the name OnSite Access, Inc. (id., note 9).

regulatory, and other relevant areas. Attached hereto as Exhibit 4 is a description of the telecommunications experience and expertise of OnSite's key management personnel. As the biographical information of OnSite's key personnel reflects, these individuals have substantial experience in running major telecommunications operations. Each member of OnSite's management team will draw upon his or her own experience, as well as the collective experience of the entire management team, to ensure that OnSite is managed and operated effectively, efficiently, and profitably. Exhibit 4 describes the technical and managerial experience of OnSite's personnel in greater detail.

9. Applicant is currently authorized to provide competitive local exchange telecommunications services in the following states: California, Connecticut, District of Columbia, Illinois, Massachusetts, New Jersey, and New York. Applicant has a pending application to provide competitive local exchange telecommunications services in Florida, Georgia, Maryland, Minnesota, Oregon, Pennsylvania, and Virginia. In addition, OnSite is currently authorized to provide resold intrastate interexchange telecommunications services, by virtue of certification, registration or tariff requirements, or on an unregulated basis, in California, Colorado, Connecticut, Illinois, Iowa, Montana, Massachusetts, New Jersey, New York, Utah, and Virginia. Applicant has pending applications to provide such service in Florida, Georgia, Maryland, Minnesota, North Carolina, Oregon and Pennsylvania. As a non-dominant common carrier, OnSite is not required to hold Federal Communications Commission authorization to provide domestic interstate telecommunications services. Furthermore, Applicant has never been denied any request for authority to provide telecommunications services.

III. PROPOSED SERVICES

- 10. OnSite proposes to provide resold and facilities-based intrastate basic local telecommunications services throughout the State of Missouri and, therefore, seeks statewide authorization. Applicant seeks authority to provide basic local exchange telecommunications services in all exchanges currently served by Southwestern Bell Telephone Company (SWBT), GTE and Sprint. A list of the SWBT, GTE, and Sprint exchanges in which Applicant seeks authority is set forth on Exhibit 5. Pursuant to applicable law, and subject to Applicant's right under federal or state laws to seek to offer, and offer and provide service in geographical areas smaller than an exchange or in market segmentations or to offer customer specific pricing, similarly situated subscribers located within the listed exchanges will receive services on equal terms and conditions as set forth in Applicant's tariffs.
- 11. Applicant intends to offer its services in accord with its tariffs. The provisions of 4 CSR 240-2.060(4)(H) require that a proposed tariff with a forty-five (45) day effective date be included with this application, and Applicant wishes to comply with this requirement. Because negotiations are not final with any of the incumbent local exchange companies in whose territory Applicant intends to provide service, the charges for interconnection and network elements, and other material provisions and terms have not been concluded, and Applicant requests the Commission to waive the provisions of this rule. Applicant intends to supply its proposed tariffs to the Commission with at least a thirty-day effective date at or near the time its interconnection agreements are approved.

12. Applicant also agrees that:

A. It will file and maintain basic local exchange service tariff(s) with the Commission in the same manner and form as the Commission requires of

- incumbent local exchange telecommunications companies with which applicant will compete;
- B. It will meet the minimum basic local service standards, including quality of service and billing standards, as the Commission may require of the incumbent local exchange telecommunications companies with which it will compete;
- C. It will offer basic local telecommunications service as a separate and distinct service and will offer basic service within the exchange boundaries of the exchanges identified in Exhibit 5, unless authorized by this Commission, or any other agency having jurisdiction, to offer and provide service in areas smaller than an exchange pursuant to Section 392.200.4 RSMo. or other applicable law; and
- D. In accord with state and federal law, and with Commission rules and regulations on the issue, but without waiver of applicant's right to appear in any rulemaking proceeding or other proceeding regarding the same, Applicant will provide equitable access to subscribers within the area proposed to be served. See Section 392.455.(5), RSMo.
- 13. Applicant requests classification as a competitive basic local exchange telecommunications company within the State of Missouri. Applicant further requests classification of services described in its proposed tariff as competitive services consistent with the Telecommunications Act of 1996. Such request includes classification of exchange access services as competitive services.

- 14. Applicant will comply with all applicable Commission rules and regulations except those which are specifically waived by the Commission pursuant to Applicant's request.
- 15. Applicant also respectfully requests, pursuant to Section 392.420, RSMo 1994 that the Commission suspend, waive or modify the application of the following rules and statutory provisions as it relates to the regulation of the Applicant as a competitive basic exchange telecommunications company:

16. 




