DATE: May 24, 2000

On April 6, 2000, Paul V. Slatinsky sent a letter to the Commission requesting cancellation of his certificate of service authority to provide private pay telephone service. The certificate was granted to Mr. Slatinsky as an individual doing business under his own name in Case No. TA-96-387. According to Mr. Slatinsky's letter, he sold his business in August of 1999 and therefore believes that he does not owe any assessment. Mr. Slatinsky sold his payphones to Wavelength, a payphone provider certificated in Case No. TA-98-245.

On April 24, 2000, the Commission issued an Order Directing Staff Investigation. The Order directs Staff to investigate and file a report and recommendation no later than May 24, 2000, concerning Mr. Slatinsky's request to cancel his certificate, his request to waive assessments, and the purported transfer of his facilities.

The Telecommunications Department Staff (Staff) contacted the Internal Accounting Department and was advised that Mr. Slatinsky's delinquent assessment payment has been waived. A copy of a memorandum from Helen Davis is attached to this recommendation. According to Ms. Davis, Mr. Slatinsky has been advised that the assessment was waived. Although Mr. Slatinsky sold telecommunications assets without having first secured Commission authority to do so, the Staff believes that it would serve little purpose to require him to file an application seeking approval retroactive to the transaction, especially since Mr. Slatinsky has ceased to provide payphone service in Missouri and has requested cancellation of his certificate of service authority. Therefore, Staff recommends that the Commission issue an order to cancel Mr. Slatinsky's certificate of service authority to provide private pay telephone service and take no action regarding his failure to file an application to transfer his assets.

FY-2000 Assessment

The Internal Accounting Department has waived the delinquent FY-2000 assessment payment for Paul V. Slatinsky.
