**ALTERNATIVE HEARING PROCEDURE
PROPOSALS**

Pursuant to discussions of the parties participating in the Prehearing Conference held on February 8 and 9, 1999, two alternative proposals concerning the procedures to be utilized for the hearings scheduled in this case are hereby presented for the Commission's consideration.

Although no agreement was reached as to which of the two proposals should be utilized, all parties participating in the Prehearing Conference provided input into the scheduling of each proposal. All witness conflicts have been recognized and the proposed limitations on cross-examination time have been agreed to by all participating parties except for the Office of the Public Counsel ("OPC") and State of Missouri. The position of the OPC and the State of Missouri are contained within the Joint Position Statement Regarding Hearing Procedure filed by those parties on February 9, 1999.

When it became apparent that the parties participating in the Prehearing Conference could not agree on one proposed schedule of witnesses to present to the Commission, the two alternative proposals that are attached hereto as Proposal A and Proposal B were prepared incorporating input from all parties including the OPC and the State of Missouri. Thus, either proposal can be utilized at the preference of the Commission without requiring additional input

from the parties. Even though the OPC and the State of Missouri do not agree as to the time limitations for cross-examination, counsel for each did participate in the preparation of Proposals A and B relating to witness availability and the make-up of the panels.

Proposal A presents a hybrid approach for the presentation of this case. It provides for the traditional cross-examination of each witness by the parties during the mornings, and an opportunity for the Commission to question the witnesses in a panel format in the afternoons. This proposal recognizes that the Commission may need to be absent from the hearing room to conduct other Commission business, such as agenda meetings, during the mornings. The afternoons have been set aside for the Commission to focus on specific checklist items by utilizing panel groups. This proposal would assume that the morning hearing schedule would end at approximately 1:00 p.m. and the afternoon sessions would be conducted from 2:00 p.m. until 5:00 p.m.

Proposal B presents an approach that utilizes panels, exclusively. The panelists would undergo cross-examination from parties and Commissioners as members of the panels. Those parties participating in the Prehearing Conference are in agreement that cross-examination questions can be directed at a specific individual on the panel if the examining parties chooses to do so. Thus, the examining party is still in control of the cross-examination even though the entire panel will be available for cross-examination at one time.


Southwestern Bell Telephone Company ("SWBT") and the Staff of the Public Service Commission ("Staff") recommend that the Commission Order that Proposal A be adopted for this proceeding because it allows for more focused cross examination and a better opportunity for the Commission to discuss the issues with each witness since the individual panels will be available at the same time each afternoon. Although this case is not a contested case within the

meaning of Section 536.010 RSMo 1994 in that this is not "a proceeding before an agency in which legal rights, duties or privileges of specific parties are required by law to be determined after hearing," Southwestern Bell believes a traditional cross examination approach will produce a more coherent record. MCI Telecommunications Corporation, an MCIWorldCom Company ("MCI"), AT&T Communications of the Southwest, Inc. ("AT&T"), Birch Telcom of Missouri, Inc. ("Birch"), Sprint Communications Company L.P. ("Sprint"), Intermedia Communications, Inc., specifically indicated their preference for Proposal B. These companies suggest that the use of the panels, on an exclusive basis, would provide for a more efficient use of the limited time that has been set aside for this proceeding. Additionally, they expressed a desire to have all the testimony on each checklist item in one general location in the record. Counsel for these parties indicated that they have participated in proceedings in other jurisdictions where panels have been utilized and that they had generally been very useful in eliciting information.

Either proposal utilizes all witnesses who have filed testimony on at least one of the panels. Thus, the Commission is assured that any witness who has presented pre-filed testimony will be available for questions.
