ORDER DIRECTING COMPLIANCE

On February 4, 1999, the Commission issued its Order Approving Interconnection Agreement. This order directed the parties, GTE Midwest Incorporated and GTE Arkansas Incorporated and United States Telecommunications, Inc., to file a compliant copy of the interconnection agreement by February 16, 1999. The order also directed the parties to file a notice in the official case file advising the Commission that the agreement had been submitted to Staff as required. The Commission has not received either the compliant copy of the Interconnection Agreement or the related notice. The parties shall have twenty days to file this agreement or show cause why they should not be subject to penalties under Sections 386.570 and 392.360, RSMo 1994, for failure to comply with the Commission's order.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That GTE Midwest Incorporated and GTE Arkansas Incorporated and United States Telecommunications, Inc., shall file a compliant copy of the Interconnection Agreement with the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission, with the pages numbered seriatim at the bottom of the

pages, no later than March 22, 1999. The parties shall file on the same date a notice in the official case file advising the Commission that the agreement has been properly submitted.

2. That this order shall become effective on March 12, 1999.
