MOTION FOR CONTINUATION OF PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

COMES NOW OnFiber Carrier Services, Inc. ("OnFiber") and moves the Public Service Commission ("Commission") to continue the Procedural Schedule in the above-captioned matter and, in support thereof, states as follows:

1. On October 11, 2000, the Commission issued its Order Adopting Procedural Schedule, which among other things, requires OnFiber to file its direct testimony on or before October 30, 2000.

2. On October 27, 2000, OnFiber filed its Motion to Amend the Application of OnFiber Carrier Services, Inc. to Delete the Request for Authority to Provide Basic Local Exchange Service ("Motion to Amend the Application").

3. OnFiber has today circulated to the parties a revised Stipulation and Agreement in light of the Motion to Amend the Application.

4. OnFiber has a good faith belief that as a result of OnFiber's Motion to Amend the Application, this matter can be quickly resolved by the Stipulation and Agreement.


5. OnFiber requires additional time to finalize and file same.
