## MOTION FOR CONTINUATION OF PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

COMES NOW OnFiber Carrier Services, Inc. ("OnFiber") and moves the Public Service Commission ("Commission") to continue the Procedural Schedule in the above-captioned matter and, in support thereof, states as follows:

- On October 11, 2000, the Commission issued its Order Adopting Procedural Schedule, which among other things, requires OnFiber to file its direct testimony on or before October 30, 2000.
- On October 27, 2000, On Fiber filed its Motion to Amend the Application of On Fiber Carrier Services, Inc. to Delete the Request for Authority to Provide Basic Local Exchange Service ("Motion to Amend the Application").
- 3. On Fiber has today circulated to the parties a revised Stipulation and Agreement in light of the Motion to Amend the Application.
- 4. On Fiber has a good faith belief that as a result of On Fiber's Motion to Amend the Application, this matter can be quickly resolved by the Stipulation and Agreement.
  - 5. On Fiber requires additional time to finalize and file same.
- 6. Therefore, OnFiber requests that the current Procedural Schedule be continued for three weeks, which in the event that the Stipulation and Agreement does not resolve this matter, OnFiber's direct testimony will be due on or before November 20, 2000.

WHEREFORE, OnFiber hereby requests a three week continuance of the Procedural Schedule.
