ORDER SUSPENDING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On April 28, 2000, OnFiber Carrier Services, Inc. (OnFiber), filed an application for authority to provide and/or resell basic local, local exchange and interexchange telecommunications services in the state of Missouri under 4 CSR 240-2.060. On July 28, 2000, the Commission granted OnFiber's Motion to Amend by Interlineation the First Page of the Application. OnFiber filed a second motion to amend the application on October 27, 2000, asking that the Commission delete its request for authority to provide basic local exchange service. The Commission granted this request on November 17, 2000.

OnFiber filed a Motion for Continuation of Procedural Schedule on October 30, 2000, indicating that OnFiber expects that this matter may be resolved by stipulation and agreement. On November 3, 2000, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) filed its response indicating that it does not oppose the request. However, Staff noted that an application to provide interexchange telecommunications service does not ordinarily require a stipulation and agreement. Staff states that it could file a memorandum addressing



OnFiber's amended application within 15 days of the motion to amend the application being granted by the Commission.

The Commission has reviewed OnFiber's motions, Staff's response, and the official case file, and finds that it is appropriate to stay the procedural schedule until otherwise ordered by the Commission.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the procedural schedule previously adopted in this matter is stayed pending further order of the Commission.

2. That this order shall become effective on December 12, 2000.
