On May 29, 2000, I received a letter from Mark G. Essig (forwarded to me from the Department of Economic Development, Director's office), regarding Kansas City Power & Light. The Commission is currently considering the same issues as to those set out in this document in Case No. **EC-99-553**. The Commission is bound by the same *ex parte* rule as a court of law.

Pursuant to 4 CSR 240-4.020(4) it is improper for any person to attempt to sway the judgement of the Commission by undertaking, directly or indirectly, outside the hearing process, to bring pressure or influence to bear upon the Commission, or the Regulatory Law Judge assigned to the proceeding.

Whenever such contact might occur 4 CSR 240-4.020(a) states: as *ex parte* communications (either oral or written) may occur inadvertently, any member of the Commission or Regulatory Law Judge who received the communication shall immediately prepare a written report concerning the communication and submit it to the Chair and each member of the Commission. The report shall identify the person(s) who participated in the *ex parte* communication, the circumstances which resulted in the communication, the substance of the communication, and the relationship of the communication to a particular matter at issue before the Commission.

Therefore, out of an abundance of caution, I think it appropriate to submit this notice of *ex parte* contact pursuant to the standards set out in the rules cited above. This will ensure that any party to this case will have notice of the attached information and a full and fair opportunity to respond to the comments contained therein.

On two previous occasions I have visited with you expressing our concern about KCPL's deteriorating maintenance practices and availability of generating capacity. Although we have had our hearing before the MPSC and all the testimony and briefs are now public knowledge the problem still exists. On May 25th, at about 11:00 p.m., another explosion occurred in a high voltage transformer near KCPL's Hawthorn Plant. This explosion and an associated intense fire suddenly cut off electrical power to GST Steel's facility. This disruption of electricity caused the caster to break out and spilled tons of molten steel (2900° Fahrenheit) onto the floor. This created a major safety risk for our workers. This episode will cost GST Steel in excess of \$500,000 due to lost production, clean up and repairs.

As we said at our last meeting, KCPL's performance is following a trend similar to the one taken over the last several years by Commonwealth Edison in Chicago. As you recall Chicago suffered major service disruption last year due to poor management of its transmission and distribution facilities. We would hope your office would take all necessary steps to insure that this does not happen in Kansas City.

We are willing to be of any assistance necessary to help you prevent this.
