YOU ARE NOTIFIED THAT each applicant listed in the schedules this notice has applied to the Commission for a accompanying certificate of service authority to provide intrastate telecommunications services. The certificate requested may be for provision of: 1) interexchange, 2) nonswitched local exchange, or 3) basic local exchange telecommunications services, or a combination thereof under Sections 392.410 through 392.4551. Commission may classify a company as competitive if it finds that all the telecommunications services the company offers are competitive If the Commission's Staff makes a favorable services. § 392.361.3. recommendation and no request for hearing is filed, the Commission may act upon a verified application without hearing. State ex rel. Deffenderfer v. P.S.C., 776 S.W.2d 494 (Mo. App. The Commission ordinarily waives the application of the statutes and Commission rules listed below for competitive companies.
