- 1. On June 1, 2018, Senate Bill 564 was signed into law. The bill contains an emergency clause which states that Section 393.137 RSMo "...shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and approval."
- 2. Section 393.137.3 RSMo requires the Company to adjust prospective rates to reflect the impact of the federal 2017 Tax Cut and Jobs Act no later than 90 days after the effective date of that section of the law.
- 3. Consequently, Ameren Missouri requests that the Missouri Public Service Commission open this docket in order to implement the above cited law.

WHEREFORE, the Company requests that the Commission open this docket to reduce Ameren Missouri's electric rates to reflect the impact of the federal 2017 Tax Cut and Jobs Act.
