If no one requests intervention or a hearing, the Commission may act upon a verified application without hearing. State ex rel. Rex Deffenderfer Enterprises, Inc. v. Public Service Commission, 776 S.W. 2d 494, 496 (Mo. App. 1989). You may obtain a copy of an application for service authority filed with the Commission by sending a written request to the Secretary at the above address.

The Records Department of the Commission is directed to send a copy of this Order and Notice to every telecommunications company that provides basic local exchange service in Missouri.
